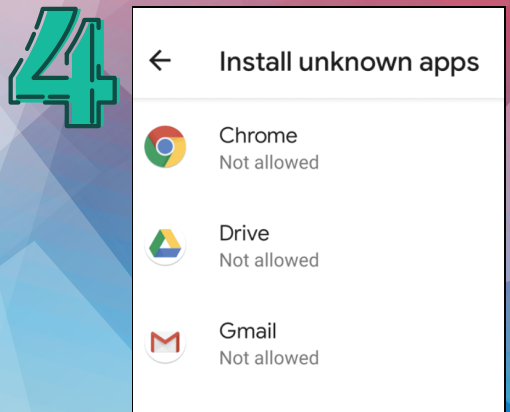
Enable Two-Factor Authentication on your Google account

Disable "Unknown Sources" and Developer Mode



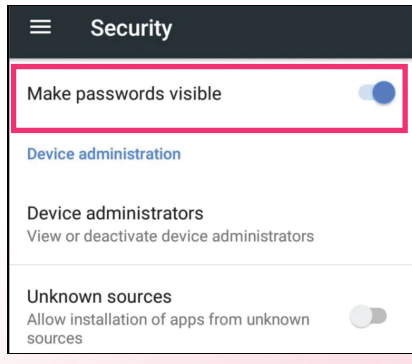
