

Money Monsters Challenge 2021

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Money Monsters Challenge is organised and administered by GEMMA.
You can contact us via gemma@gov.mt
2. In these terms and conditions “**We**”, “**Us**” or “**Our**” means GEMMA and “**You**”, “**Your**”, or the “**Organisation**” means primary school, or other educational establishment that participates in the **Money Monsters Competition 2021** (also known as the “**Challenge**”), or the parent or guardian who submits an entry on behalf of an Entrant. “**Entrant**” means any child or young person who partakes in the Challenge.
3. The Competition is open to residents of Malta who are aged between 6 and 11 years (inclusive). Entries from outside Malta will not be considered.
4. Entry to the Competition is free of charge.
5. Adult (that is, a parent or guardian of the Entrant), permission is required for the Entrant to agree to the terms and enter the Challenge.
6. Where entries are submitted by the Entrant’s school or other educational establishment, You shall ensure that the parent and /or guardian of each Entrant has provided consent for the Entrant to enter into the Competition and for the Entrant’s personal information to be provided and used by GEMMA and You shall ensure that a record of such consents is maintained by You during the Challenge.
7. We will not be responsible for any claims made by an Entrant and/or their parents or guardians that allege any entries were affected and/or personal data (including, but not limited to work or photographs) were uploaded without the appropriate consents.
8. To enter the Challenge, Entrants will need to provide GEMMA with their name, age, school/ educational establishment name and submit their Challenge entry through either a parent/ guardian or a teacher/trainer/facilitator at a school or other educational establishment. The parent/guardian or teacher/trainer/facilitator must provide GEMMA with details of the Entrant’s school or other educational establishment, as well as their own name, address, telephone number and email address. GEMMA will only use Entrants’ personal details for the purposes of administering the Challenge.
9. Only one entry will be accepted per Entrant.
10. Entries must be 2D and no larger than an A3 page. If the Challenge criteria expressly allows, photographic evidence of 3D or large Entries may also be submitted. Entries can be either landscape or portrait, either handwritten/ hand drawn, or a printed hard copy created on a computer. Entries can be in black or white or in colour. Entries should address the specific theme of the category being entered. Entry format is not restricted and can take the form of a story, poem, article or illustration depending on the competition requirements for the particular category. In order to qualify for judging, all entries must be accompanied by a completed copy of the teacher/trainer/facilitator entry form (either hard copy or online) and the correct completed Challenge Summary Sheet for the category they are entering. Each page of an entry must contain the full Entrant name, age and school/educational establishment name, written clearly at the top.

11. The Challenge will commence on 1st June 2021 and close 30th September 2021. All valid entries received before the closing date will be considered by the judges. Entries will be shortlisted by our GEMMA Money Monsters Challenge team in accordance with and subject to the criteria set out in the Challenge Guidelines provided for each category. The final shortlisted Entries will be judged by an external panel. The judges will assess innovation, flair, creativity and enthusiasm when judging Entries. The judges' decision is final. No correspondence between judges and Organisations, or Entrants will be entered into.
12. Successful Entrants will be notified by the 2nd week of October 2021.
13. The address provided on the teacher/trainer/facilitator online entry form will be used to send any prizes, and the telephone number and email address will be used to notify winners. Please make sure these are correct.
14. No responsibility can be accepted for any entries lost, delayed or mislaid for any reason whatsoever. Proof of sending is not proof of receipt. Entries may only be submitted via the submission link at www.gemma.gov.mt/moneymonsterschallenge/ will be accepted. Postal submissions will not be accepted.
15. All expenses incurred as part of entering the Challenge, unless specifically stated otherwise, are the sole responsibility of the Entrant.
16. The judges' decision regarding winners is final and no correspondence will be entered.
17. All Challenge entries and any accompanying material submitted to GEMMA will become the property of GEMMA on receipt and will not be returned. If Entrants would like to keep the original artwork, they are asked to submit a copy as their entry.
18. By submitting a Challenge entry and any accompanying material, Entrants agree to:
 - assign to GEMMA all intellectual property rights in the entry with full title guarantee; and
 - surrender all moral rights (including the right to be identified as author of the entry and the right to control modifications to and destruction of the entry) in and to the Entrants' Challenge entry and otherwise arising in connection with the entry to which the Entrant may now or at any time in the future be entitled under the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988 as amended from time to time and under all similar legislation from time to time in force anywhere in the world.
19. You and each Entrant warrant and agree that:
 - so far as You are aware the Entrants named on the Challenge Summary Sheet accompanying each entry are (and will be) the sole creators and authors of that entry;
 - the Entrants have the right to make the entry to and for all purposes of the Challenge;
 - the entry will not infringe upon, misappropriate or otherwise violate any third party intellectual property right or proprietary right including, without limitation, any registered or unregistered trademark, copyright, design rights or patent, nor any privacy rights, moral rights nor any other rights of any person or entity;
 - the entry does not contain any content which violates or infringes upon the rights of others, which is unlawful, threatening, abusive, defamatory, invasive of privacy or publicity rights, vulgar, obscene, profane, indecent or otherwise objectionable, which encourages conduct or is conduct that would constitute a criminal offence, gives rise to civil liability or otherwise violates any applicable law.
20. By entering the Challenge, Entrants agree that any personal information provided with the Challenge entry may be held and used only by GEMMA or its agents and suppliers to administer the Challenge.
21. Entrants may be required to take part in promotional activity and GEMMA reserves the right to use the names, schools of winners, their photographs and audio and/or visual recordings of them in any publicity related to the Challenge and may be invited to take part in television or other media campaigns.

22. Prizes

- a. There will be **one** overall winner in Primary Category. The winner will receive **one** €50 One4All gift card.
- b. There will be **two** runner-up winners in Primary Category. The runners-up will each receive **one** €25 One4All gift card .

23. Prizes are not negotiable and cannot be transferred

24. Prizes for schools/educational establishments will not be awarded or transferable to individuals.

25. No part of the non-cash prizes is exchangeable for cash or any other prize.

26. If an advertised prize is not available, we reserve the right to offer an alternative prize of equal or greater value.

27. Insofar as is permitted by law, GEMMA, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the winner or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up the prize except where it is caused by the negligence of GEMMA, its agents or distributors or that of their employees. The Entrant's legal rights are not affected.

28. By entering the Challenge, You and the Entrants agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless GEMMA and its respective affiliated companies and all of its respective past and present officers, directors, employees, agents and representatives from and against any and all claims, expenses, and liabilities (including legal fees), including but not limited to negligence and damages of any kind to persons and property, defamation, infringement of trademark, copyright, design right or other intellectual property rights, property damage, or death or personal injury arising out of or relating to Your entry or participation in the Challenge.

29. You shall be responsible for the health and safety of all Entrants and compliance with all relevant legal requirements.

30. GEMMA reserves the right to amend, suspend or cancel the Challenge where it becomes necessary to do so or due to circumstances beyond its control.
